UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA SCHOOL OF LAW

The Virginia Loan Forgiveness Program (VLFP) assists University of Virginia Law School graduates who are entering public service employment with their law school educational loan debts. You must apply within two years of graduation (i.e., December 1, 2008 for 2006 graduates) or within two years of completing a judicial clerkship which is taken immediately after graduation and is no longer than two years. Rules governing the Program are available in the Office of Financial Aid (SL235) and on the Law School's Web site (www.law.virginia.edu).

Assistance is provided on a calendar-year basis and can begin as early as the first year after the year of graduation. The Law School Foundation will disburse VLFP funds to re-applicants who submit completed applications by November 1, in January of each year. New applicants with completed applications submitted by December 15, will receive fund disbursements in February. Participants receiving financial assistance will be required to sign a Promissory Note prior to receiving VLFP funds setting forth their obligation to repay program loans that are not subsequently forgiven.

Please complete the attached application and submit it with the supporting materials listed on Page 2 of the application. *To expedite the application process, please label the supporting documentation clearly.* Incomplete applications will not be processed until all required documentation has been received. You are encouraged to notify the Office of Financial Aid via letter or e-mail of your interest in applying after the deadline so that we can follow up with you on a regular basis.

Re-applications should be submitted by **November 1, 2006.**
New applications should be submitted by **December 15, 2006.**

_____ B. ***Documentation from lenders*** indicating the face amounts of law school loans, the interest rate, and the monthly payment amounts (ordinarily a current bill or statement of account printed from the lender's web site). Loans must be in active repayment status. **Documentation must demonstrate a decline in total loan balances for the prior program year.**

_____ C. ***2005 federal tax return, including the W-2.***

_____ D. ***If married***, proof of spouse's salary, spouse's 2005 tax return (if not a joint return with applicant), and documentation from lenders indicating the amount of spouse's graduate school loan debt and monthly payment amounts.

_____ E. If applicable, ***statement*** describing additional non-taxable funds such as non-taxable foreign income, income of a non-citizen spouse, subsistence allowances of military personnel and certain grant/fellowship recipients, and/or a statement describing any facts that would cause the applicant's or spouse's AGI to differ by more than 10% from that on the most recent tax return.

_____ A. ***Proof of salary and public service employment*** (most recent pay stub **AND** a letter from employer indicating projected salary for 2007).

_____ C. ***2005 federal tax return, including the W-2***, if available.

_____ D. ***If married***, proof of spouse's salary, spouse's 2005 tax return (if not a joint return with applicant), and documentation from lenders indicating the amount of spouse's graduate school loan debt and monthly payment amounts.

_____ E. If applicable, ***statement*** describing additional non-taxable funds such as non-taxable foreign income, income of a non-citizen spouse, and/or subsistence allowances of military personnel and certain grant/fellowship recipients.
