## Additional information about the clinic:

- Our delinquency cases are primarily in Albemarle and Charlottesville Juvenile & Domestic Relations Court. The Albemarle delinquency docket is on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month (starting at 9:00 am) and the Charlottesville delinquency docket is on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month (starting at 9:00 am). Clinic students who wish to observe court or appear for clients' matters should plan their course schedules accordingly.
- Case emergencies can occur at any time, so some evening or weekend work may be required. Clinic students should expect to spend approximately 15 hours per week working on their cases, appearing in court, and/or preparing for class. The hours required for clinic work will vary according to the demands of the cases and will vary from week to week.
