Course Enrollment/Registration: Are students pre-enrolled or pre-registered? If yes, can students do this themselves on-line?	Students complete an Enrolment task online which enrolls them in 24 credit points after they have accepted 4 units of study. The enrolment process is flexible with students able to change their enrolled subjects up to the end of the first week of class by submitting an appropriate form to their advisor in Sydney.
Costs in addition to tuition charged, including any fee charged for transferring or receiving credit earned there	As a guide, a single student living away from home will spend anywhere between \$1,500 and \$2,200 every month on accommodation, food, utilities and entertainment. Requirements for student performance and grading methods	Students must have achieved a minimum 3.0 GPA in order to be admitted at the University of Sydney. Students are graded at the University of Sydney in 5 categories. High Distinction with a grade of 85-100, Distinction with a grade of 75-84, Credit with a grade of 65-74, Pass with a grade of 50-64 and Fail with a grade of 49 or below.
Extent to which country, city and facilities are accessible to disabled individuals	Australia in general is relatively accessible for disabled individuals, particularly the larger cities. More remote locations may not have the same accessibility. The University of Sydney has a team dedicated to disability support for students https://sydney.edu.au/study/academic-support/disability-support.html
Information on availability, approximate cost, and location of housing	Accommodation, living costs, etc are additional costs - you are free to choose whichever accommodation option best suits your personal preferences and budget. One of our most popular accommodation options is a guaranteed accommodation arrangement with Urbanest, one of the top student accommodation providers in Australia. Students are provided with the application form soon after receiving an offer letter for one of our programs.
Health Insurance Requirements: Do exchange students have to purchase health insurance? Does your university offer health insurance? If so, how much does this cost per semester?	As an Exchange student you will receive a tuition fee waiver. You will be responsible for paying the compulsory overseas student health insurance (called OSHC) which is currently AUD\$330 for one semester and AUD\$660 for two semesters (2018 rates). <i>(This is in addition to the CISI Insurance that University of Virginia requires the student to purchase in order to go on exchange.)</i>
