



**2019 Han C. Choi Scholarship**  
**Deadline: March 1, 2019 at 5:00 PM EST**

The NAPABA Law Foundation has partnered with the Choi Family to create the Han C. Choi Scholarship, to honor a NAPABA Trailblazer, mentor and leader, who embodies grit and courage in the face of great adversity.

**Eligibility**

- To be eligible, an applicant must be enrolled as a full time or part time 1L or 2L law student in an Association of American Law School (AALS)-accredited law school.
- The candidate must exhibit academic excellence, leadership, volunteerism, mentorship experience and demonstrate an interest in AAPI civic issues. Special consideration will also be given to applicants who have been adversely affected by cancer (as a survivor, or family member of a victim or survivor).

**Award**

- The Han C. Choi Scholarship will provide **\$5,000.00** in total for a finalist.
- Award of scholarship funds under this program must be used to further the recipient's law school education.
- Award will be presented 2019 Georgia Asian Pacific American Bar Association (GAPABA) Annual Gala. Recipient must accept award at the event. All travel and lodging expenses will be paid for by GAPABA.

**Documents Needed**

- Current resume.
- At least one letter of recommendation written within the past year.
- A personal statement of no more than 500 words, explaining:
  - Your past or present activities showing commitment to the public interest or the AAPI community.
  - If the applicant has been adversely affected by cancer (as a survivor, or family member of a victim or survivor).

**Submission & Deadline**

- The deadline for applying is 5:00 ET on March 1, 2019.
- NLF may interview candidates or request supplemental information, as appropriate. All applicants will be notified via email whether they have been selected by March 31, 2019.
